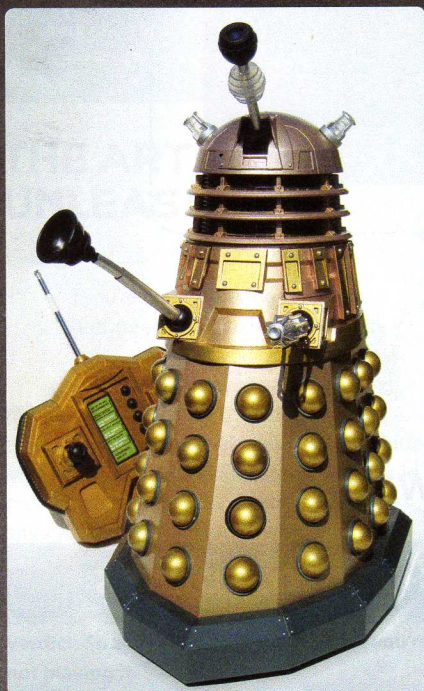
12" Radio Control Dalek

miShare

Wirelessly sharing music between portable MP3 players is easy! Just start up your Zune and... Huh? Oh...uh, Zune, Z-u-n-e. You've heard of it. We can share music directly between iPods, too, but it's going to take some hardware, and that hardware is called miShare.

Just take two iPods with dock connectors and link 'em up to the miShare, and with a touch of a single button you can copy the last song played from the source iPod to the target.
